

Ragauskas receives Full Membership in Sigma Xi

Arthur Ragauskas has received Full Membership in Sigma Xi, The Scientific Research Honor Society who publishes the American Scientist news journal.

The society was founded in 1886 at Cornell University by a group of engineering students. Sigma Xi was designed to reward excellence in scientific research and to encourage a sense of companionship and cooperation among scientists in all fields.

Sigma Xi has nearly 60,000 members in over 500 chapters in the U.S., Canada and other countries, including Switzerland, Thailand, Lebanon, New Zealand and Australia. The Oak Ridge Chapter was established in 1954. Sigma Xi chapters are found wherever scientific research is undertaken in universities, colleges, industrial research facilities and government laboratories.

Their goal continues to be a leader in advancing STEM education, cultivating the next generation of innovators, enhancing the public's confidence in the scientific enterprise, and promoting evidence-based policies.
