Annabel Large, an undergraduate student in Chemical Engineering at the University of Tennessee working in Dan Jacobson's lab, has received a grant from the Fulbright Scholar Program to work with Erik Alexandersson, a long-standing collaborator of Dan's. Erik is Associate Professor in the Department of Plant Protection and Director of PlantLink at the Swedish University of Agricultural Sciences. Annabel was concurrently accepted into the joint UC-Berkeley-UCSF PhD program, which she will defer until 2020.

Annabel has participated in research rotations at two of DOE's Bioenergy Research Centers. In summer and fall 2017, she worked at the Joint BioEnergy Institute (JBEI) at Lawrence Berkeley National Laboratory, conducting research in the automation and scale-up of synthetic biology experiments.

For the past two years, Annabel has been working full or part time in the Computational Systems Biology group of Dan Jacobson at the Oak Ridge National Laboratory on a Center for Bioenergy Innovation project.
