

Gregg Beckham Elected to the U.S. National Academy of Engineering

The U.S. National Academy of Engineering (NAE) announced its new members for 2025. Among the new class of 128 U.S.-based and 22 international NAE members are numerous chemical engineers including CBI's Dr. Gregg Beckham of the National Renewable Energy Laboratory. Gregg was elected for his leadership in biological and chemical catalysis for the valorization and creation of materials from waste plastics and biomass.

The newly elected members will be formally inducted during the NAE's Annual Meeting on October 5, 2025.
